



THE BOOK OF DISQUIET Two young and talented artists, one collaborative exhibition. Mercedes Helnwein and i-D contributor Alex Prager's combined efforts have resulted in *The Book of Disquiet*, featuring the seven deadly sins. The exhibition is accompanied by a book of the same name, done up in the style of children's board books. Alex and Mercedes worked together with filmmaker Beth Riesgraf, and together they count this exhibition as their fourth collaboration in the last three years.
